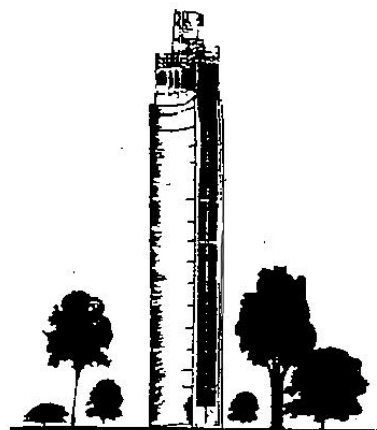

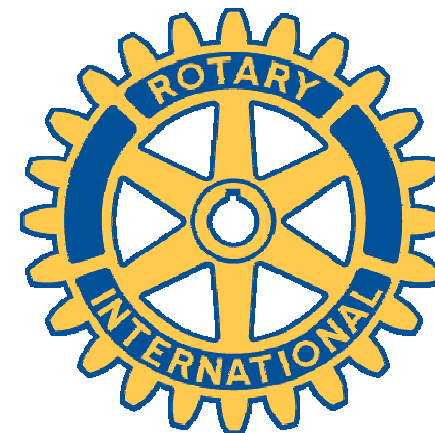

A great place to start this examination in any organization is to look at its Mission Statement. Rotary’s Mission Statement is *“The mission of Rotary International, a worldwide association of Rotary clubs, is to provide service to others, to promote high ethical standards, and to advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace through its fellowship of business, professional, and community leaders.”*

Rotary is first and foremost a service organization that seeks to make our world a better place for all to enjoy, but it is more than that. As Rotarians, we hold ourselves to a higher standard. We believe that we should conduct ourselves with the highest ethical standards in everything we do and say. We believe that it is not possible to best serve others if that service is done for the wrong reasons or in an unethical manner.
