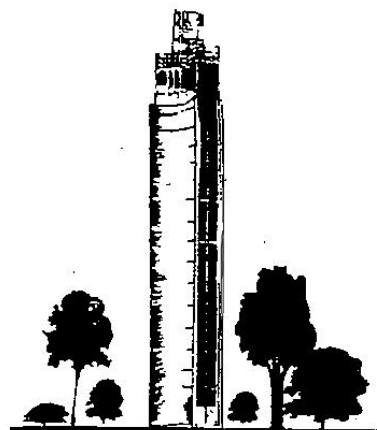

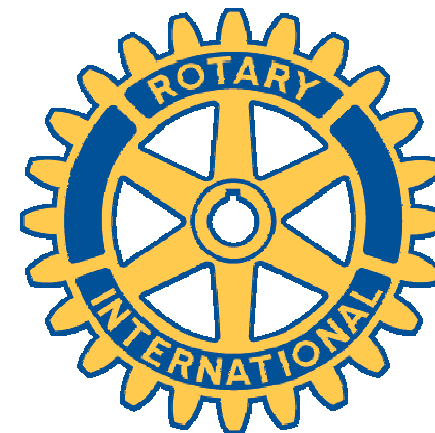

The Four Avenues of Service, A Rotary Legacy!!

Last week, we took a look at the Object of Rotary, and if you looked very carefully, you could see that the four key elements in the Object lead directly to the Four Avenues of Service. Each Avenue defines an area of a Rotarian's life in which he/she can serve others. It starts with the first Avenue, which is Club Service, in which a Rotarian works to make the club stronger and better for the enjoyment of all of the members.

Next comes the Vocational Avenue, which is often one of the most misunderstood Avenues. The idea of this Avenue comes from the second point of the Object where we all recognize that each useful occupation is worthy and each gives the opportunity to serve society.
